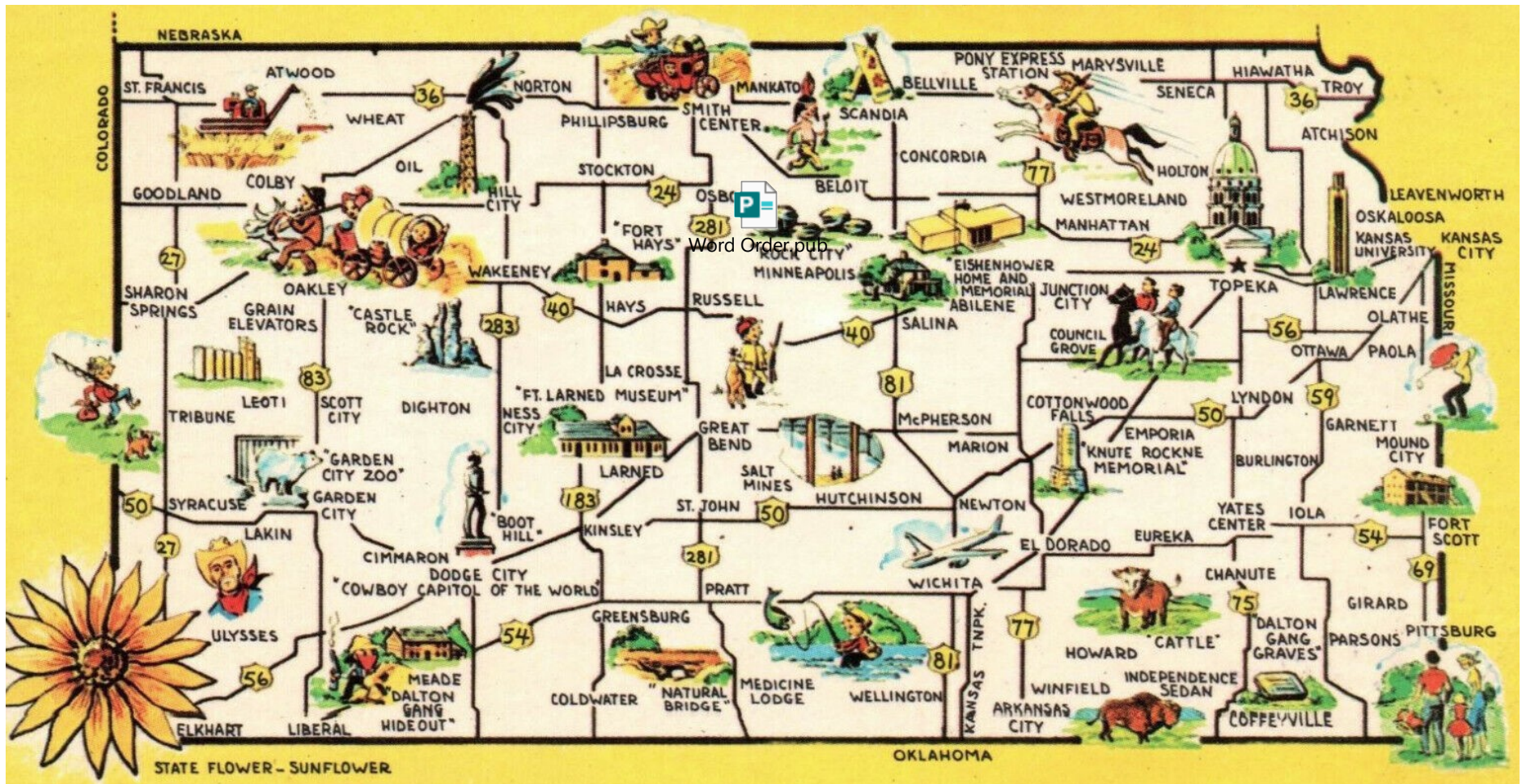


# Ishpaho<sup>n</sup>?

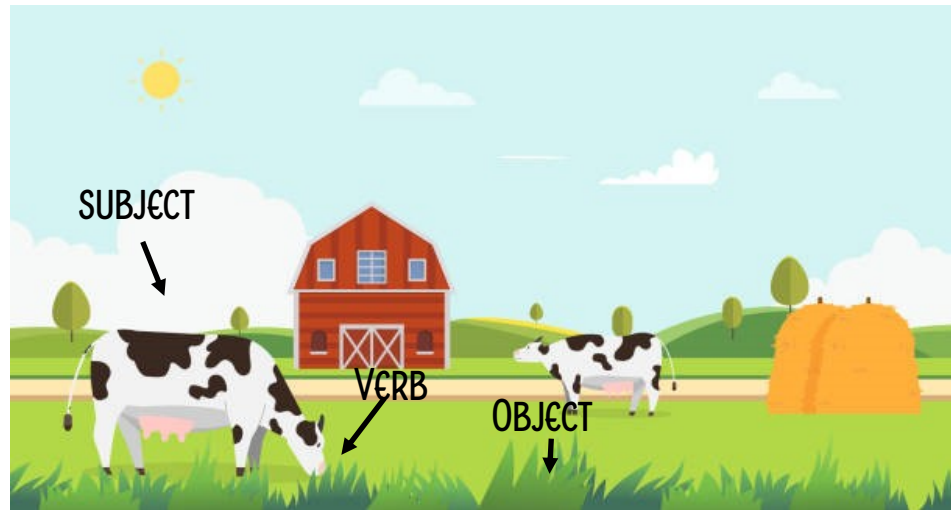
*(Did you know?)*

# WORD (WAYÁJE) ORDER



IN Kaá'ze Íe, THE **SUBJECT** ALWAYS COMES FIRST IN A SENTENCE FOLLOWED BY THE **OBJECT**, AND THEN THE **VERB**. THE VERB WILL ALWAYS COME LAST.

**CESKÁ** (COW) IS THE SUBJECT.

**Ma'hí'** (GRASS) IS THE OBJECT.

**YACHÉ** (TO EAT) IS THE VERB.
