





Cíbogha (Kaá'ze Tipi)

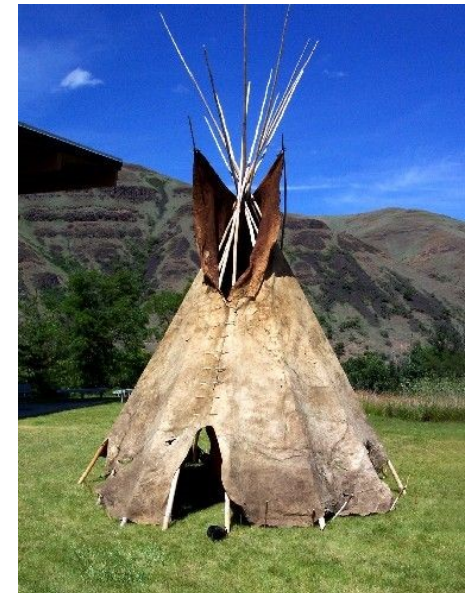
